

PACKING LIST

Don't ruin your vacation by forgetting the essentials! Here is a guide to make sure you're prepared to kick back and relax. For storage purposes, soft-sided luggage is preferred.

SWIMSUITS

Hopefully you will be spending most of your time in the water. Make sure you pack at least 2, one to swim in while the other one dries. There are no laundry facilities aboard.

MEDICATION/TOILETRIES

Remember to bring all prescribed and over the counter medications. Drug stores are hard to come by in the islands. Although shampoo and conditioner are supplied please bring all other necessities.

SUN PROTECTION

Nothing ruins a fun vacation like a sunburn! Bring sunscreen, hats, sunglasses and we highly recommend swim shirts with SPF. Do NOT bring Sum Bum brand or self tanner (it stains!)

COVERUPS/CLOTHES

Remember this is your vacation so wear what is comfortable. Aboard The Annex there is no specific dress code. You can eat lunch in your in swimsuit or in a sundress! You'll be in your swimsuit most of the day but we recommend a couple of dry outfits.

PAJAMAS

Each cabin has it's own thermostat and AC so you can control how cold or warm you would like your cabin to be- so pack your favorite pair

A NOTE ON SHOES...

Aboard The Annex, sand is the enemy and shoes bring in sand so you will be barefoot for the majority of your stay. We suggest a maximum of 3 pairs: a waterproof pair of flip flops, some sneakers if you choose to go hiking and a nice pair of sandals in case you have dinner on an island.

ELECTRONICS

There is wifi aboard the boat but not strong enough to stream videos.. Don't forget your phone, camera, and chargers (outlets are standard 15 amp duplex) Bring earbuds for the plane but make a vacation playlist to play on our sound system (make sure it is fully downloaded to avoid causing a party foul). Finally, please make sure to check with your carrier about international plans.

IF ALL ELSE FAILS...

At the end of the day if you have a swimsuit, wallet, phone and passport you are good to go :)

LEAVE AT HOME

- Towels: both bathroom and beach towels are provided
- Snorkel gear: unless you have a favorite or prescription mask
- Hair dryer- we have one aboard
- Shampoo and conditioner
- Before you pack your board games and cards, check the list that we have on board on the website under the 'About' tab

MAY WE SUGGEST?

- A book you have been dying to read
- A waterproof speaker to take on the paddle boards
- 2 pairs of sunglasses not just 1
- For those with long hair... leave in conditioner if you don't want to wash your hair every time you come out of the ocean but would like to still brush through
- A hoodie or sweater if you come in the winter- it can get chilly at night
- Sea sickness patches (prescribed by your doctor) if you get motion sickness easily
- A travel jewelry case to safe keep your valuables before you jump in the water
- For anyone getting a mani/pedi before the trip, the sun, salt, and sand will ruin regular polish quickly- opt for a gel or dip manicure :)
